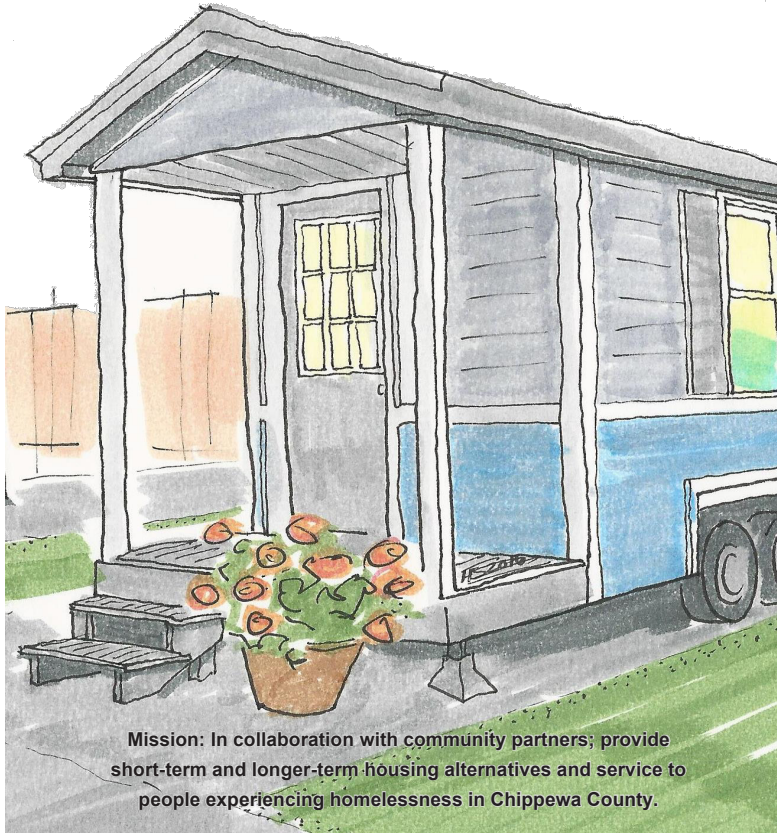

**Mission:** In collaboration with community partners; provide short-term and longer-term housing alternatives and service to people experiencing homelessness in Chippewa County.

**Hope Village Vision:**

Hope Village will be a small community of tiny homes in Chippewa County located within the city limits. Within this community, Hope Village will have a gathering space, kitchen, showers, and laundry facilities. We'll offer a "Re-Sale" store to help support guest transitions to permanent housing.

Tiny homes are small, short-term homes built on trailers, making them mobile. Area churches host tiny homes on their property and provide on-going support to tiny home guests. Tiny homes are a safe place – more than a shelter.

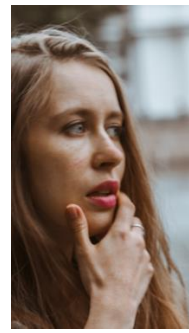
Hope Village currently has 8 tiny homes built and has funding for the final 2.

3. Permanent Housing

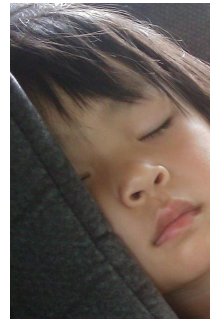
Chippewa County does not have a homeless shelter. People with shelter needs have been sent to hotels which are expensive and funding falls short of the need.

- The poverty rate (14%) in Chippewa County exceeds the Wisconsin average (10.2%)
- The Chippewa County ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) Household percentage (26%) exceeds the Wisconsin ALICE percentage (25%).
- In Chippewa County it is estimated that 75 people are homeless at any point in time.

**HOPE VILLAGE:**

- Serves about 16 families per year.
- Provides around 1,500 nights of housing per year.
- Efforts saved \$104,000 in emergency housing costs.
